This event follows a plenary session and panel discussions at the Fox School of Business earlier in the day, organized to celebrate the **100th anniversary of the International Labour Organization (ILO)**. It commemorates as well the **75th anniversary of the landmark ILO Declaration of Philadelphia in 1944 at Mitten Hall, Temple University**.

The **Declaration of Philadelphia** set a new agenda for labor rights in the post war period. It asserted the right of all people “to pursue material well-being and spiritual development under conditions of freedom, dignity, economic security and equal opportunity.” Its adoption is an important part of Philadelphia’s distinction as a World Heritage City.
